I have developed or co-developed several innovative courses for UNM in my 8 years as faculty, including interdisciplinary courses on A Systems Approach to Planetary Health (start Spring 2023) and on Climate Change and Public Health Preparedness (Spring 2020-present)which has the Golden Paw. I developed and lead the N 518 Nurse Leadership in Population Health course for the MSN Administration program.
